## TRESPASS AGREEMENT -AUTHORIZATION TO ACT AS AN AGENT

As the legal owner or as the owner's agent of the above property. I hereby authorize the Rancho Cucamonga Police Department and/or San Bernardino County Sheriff's Department to act as my agent to arrest, remove, or advise of any person present on the property without lawful business and/or permission to be present on the premises. It is also understood that the Rancho Cucamonga Police Department and/or San Bernardino County Sheriff's Department will act as my agent in my absence and/or "after closing hours" in these matters.

It is my intent under this authorization agreement to empower the Rancho Cucamonga Police Department and/or San Bernardino County Sheriff's Department under authorization of 602 (o) of the Penal Code to cause arrest, removal, or advisement of all persons in violation of section 602 (o), 555 of the California Penal Code or for other violations that occur upon my premises in my absence. I understand that by signing this form that the Rancho Cucamonga Police Department and/or the San Bernardino County Sheriff's Department shall be empowered to act as my agent for a period not to exceed a period of One Year (365) days from the date that appears next to my signature on this authorization form. My authority to act as my agent shall remain in force for the next Year (365) days unless I submit a written request to formally withdraw my authorization to act.

I have posted my above property "NO TRESPASSING" in accordance with 602 of the Penal Code. I also acknowledge that in order to enforce the Penal Code Section it is my duty to assist in the prosecution of all persons who trespass on my property. It is further understood that I may be called on to sign a complaint under this section and I hereby agree to do so. If necessary, I will testify in court that I requested the Rancho Cucamonga Police Department to order individuals or groups to leave my premises and authorized the arrest of person(s) who were in violation of one or more of the above sections while on my property.

UNDER PENAL CODE SECTION 602 (o) P.C.: Every person who willfully commits a trespass is guilty of a misdemeanor. 602 (o) P.C.: Refusing to leave land, real property, or structures belonging or lawfully occupied by another and not open to the general public upon being requested to leave by 1) a peace officer at the request of the owner, the owner's agent, or the person in lawful possession and upon being informed by the peace officer that he or she is acting at the request of the owner. 2) the owner's agent or the person in lawful possession. 602(t)(1) P.C.: Entering upon private property including contiguous land, real property, or structures thereon belonging to the same owner, whether or not generally open to the public after having been informed by the peace officer that he or she is acting at the request of the owner, the owner's agent, or the person in lawful possession that the property is not open to the particular person; or refusing or failing to leave the property upon being asked to leave the property in the manner provided in this subdivision. 555 P.C.: It is unlawful to enter or remain upon any posted property without the written permission of the owner, tenant, or occupant in legal possession or control thereof. Every person who enters or remains upon posted property without such permission is guilty of separate offense for each day during any portion of which he enters or remains upon such posted property.
